

## HEIGHT SAFETY COURSE

This course should be undertaken by people who work in situations where they are; working above the ground, on a roof, on a platform or other structures.

The course will develop the skills and knowledge to work safely at height, through assessing the risks associated and gaining an understanding of equipment required for this type of work. Personnel will also become familiar with legislative requirements that impact on such work procedures. This course is based on hazard management systems. The unit of competence is *Work safely at heights 69872*.
