

CHIEF WARDEN COURSE

This course is designed for people who are assigned the responsibility as the Chief Warden (and their deputies) in their workplace. The course is structured in accordance with Australian Standards: Emergency Control Organisation and Procedures in Buildings (AS 3745-2002) and Emergency Response for Health Care Facilities (AS 4083-1997).

Participants are exposed to relevant information for their role as a Chief Warden. This information supports the implementation of emergency procedures, staff training requirements and the roles and responsibilities of the Chief Warden in the event of an emergency that may warrant an evacuation. The unit of competence is *Lead an emergency control organisation PUAWER006B*. To obtain this unit of competence a post-course assessment is required to be completed.

- The acts and regulations relating to the Emergency Control Organisation
- The management of the evacuation
- Responding to different emergencies
- Liaising with emergency services
- Strategies in emergency prevention management
- Communication systems
- Recovery planning
