



CONFINED SPACE COURSE

This course should be undertaken by people who have a requirement to work in, on, or around confined spaces.

The course will develop the necessary skills and knowledge for working safely in confined spaces, through addressing the risks associated and equipment required for confined space entry. Personnel will also become familiar with the legislative requirements that impact on such work procedures.

The course is structured in accordance with Australian Standard: Safe Working in a Confined Space (AS 2865-2001) and supports compliance with the *Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998*. The units of competence are *Enter Confined Space MSAPMPER205B* and *Work in accordance with an issued permit MSAPMPER200B*.
