



WARDENS COURSE

This course is designed for people who are Wardens in their workplace. Having personnel attend this course can support your organisation in meeting legislative requirements such as the Workplace Health and Safety Regulations 1998 and the General Fire Regulations (where applicable).

This course is structured in accordance with Australian Standards: Emergency Control Organisation and Procedures in Buildings (AS 3745–2002) and Emergency Response for Health Care Facilities (AS 4083 – 1997). Successful participants will receive a Statement of Completion accredited by the Tasmania Fire Service.

Content

- Roles & responsibilities of wardens
- Preparing for emergencies
- Evacuation procedures
- Communicating in emergencies

The course is conducted in a classroom environment and is information based with interactive activities and opportunities, incorporating case studies, video presentation and group discussion.

Cost

The course duration is 4 hours and the fee is \$185 (GST inclusive) per participant.
