



BREATHING APPARATUS COURSE (OPEN CIRCUIT)

This course should be undertaken by people who have a requirement to use breathing apparatus in the workplace.

Participants will develop the necessary skills and knowledge for using breathing apparatus. The course will address safe use of breathing apparatus and provide participants with a sound understanding of the equipment and their capabilities.

The course is structured to provide both theory and practical exercises using a number of training scenarios. The unit of competence is *Operate Breathing Apparatus MSAPMAOHS216A*.

Content

- Conduct pre-donning checks and tests on breathing apparatus
- Start up and control procedures
- Operate breathing apparatus
- Closing down and maintaining equipment

The course is designed to give the participant the confidence to use the breathing apparatus safely in the workplace.

Cost

The course duration is 4 hours and the fee is \$175 (GST exempt) per participant
